colour	Pale straw colour
nose	Youthful, vibrant Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Lime sherbet and floral aromas infuse with the lively grass and gooseberry characters.
palate	Lush, lively and fruit-driven with flavours of gooseberries, lemon-lime citrus, feijoa and a strong mineral or wet stone element. Natural fruit weight and texture with balanced acidity.
general	<p>Machine harvested from one vineyard in the Wairau Valley of Marlborough, where the soil is free-draining with a loam topsoil and stony silt underneath.</p> <p>Cool stainless steel fermentation, with a portion (5%) undergoing fermentation in new French oak barriques. Filtered and bottled early to capture the vibrancy and essence of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.</p>
